- In 1929, the names was changed to Gazi Secondary Teacher Training School and Civility Institute
- In 1982, the name was changed into Gazi University.

- Gazi University is one of the biggest universities in Turkey with
 - 18 faculties
 - 4 colleges
 - 1 State Conservatory of Turkish Music
 - 5 Vocational college
 - 55 Research Centers
 - And 7 Institutes

Gazi Faculty of Education

- Was founded in 1926
