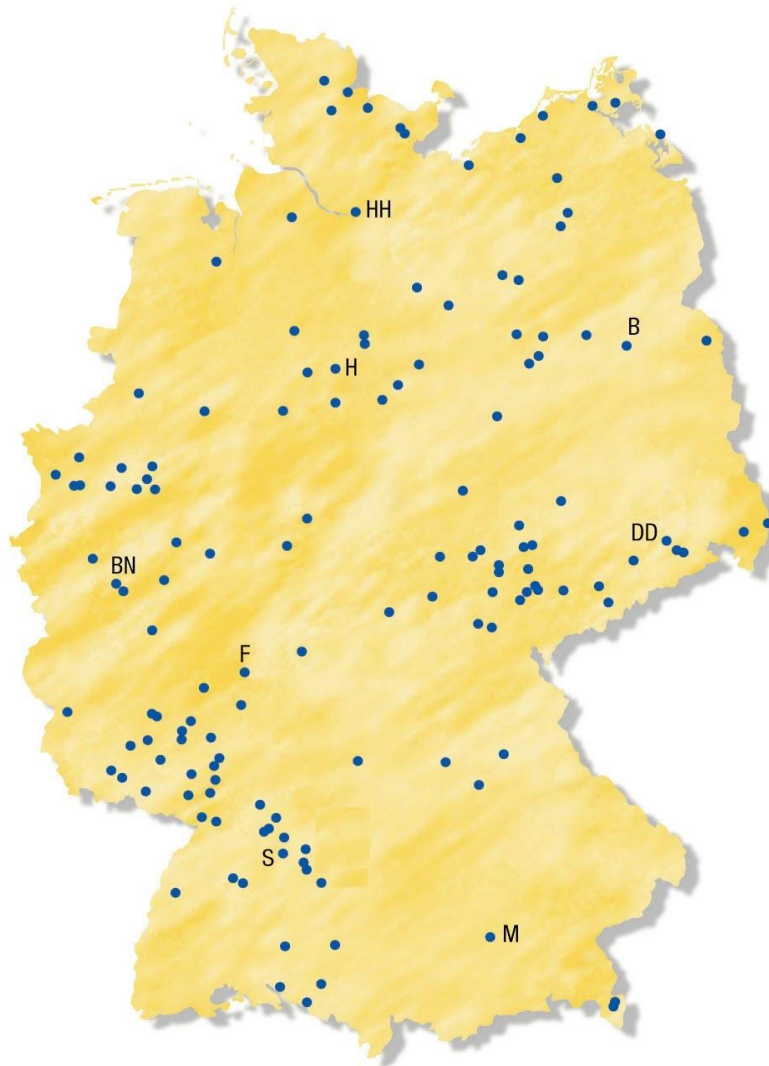

CJD – an overview (2)



- Founded in 1947 to support people who had been left homeless and directionless by the war
- The aim “Nobody shall left behind”
- Nowadays: an organization for youth, education & social work (NGO)
- Headquarter in Ebersbach (southern Germany)
- More than 150 locations (organized within 19 associations)
- Almost 10.000 employees
- 155.000 supported people/year

CJD – specific areas

- Active in these specific areas
 - elementary education
 - e.g. nursery schools, kindergardens, after school care
 - academic education
 - ca. 50 schools (Germany's largest private school provider for pupils with disabilities to highly intelligent)
 - child, youth and family assistance
 - day care, various mobile assistance and in-house facilities
 - vocational training
 - career guidance counselling, career start mentoring, full vocational training in CJD institutions and workshops

CJD – specific areas (2)

• ...

- health and rehabilitation
 - career education centres, career support centres or other institutions for occupational rehabilitation (prevention of disease, care of chronic syndromes, indication-based therapy)
- work and activities
 - offers and services to people with a disability or various other problems
- housing and care services
 - housing and care services tailored to the individual needs
- other
 - guest houses, international projects

- Opened in the 1970s
- Three locations with 11 sub-locations
- Ca. 1000 supported people/year (some are living on the campus)
- Activities
 - elementary education
 - child, youth and family assistance
 - vocational training
 - health and rehabilitation
 - work and activities
 - housing and care services
 - other services such as integration/migration & guest houses

CJD Olpe elementary education/KITA



- Opened in the 1990s
- Three locations with around 19 employees
 - 4th will be officially part of CJD in August 2017
- 25; 20 +10 and 15 from 0–6 years, incl. 2–5 with special needs
- Flexible working hours
- Experiencing: healthy growing up, language, learning with all senses, arts, culture, nature: music, dancing, theater, painting
- Bilingual (English, German)
- Values: growing up in a multicultural context
- Participation: kids can contribute with own ideas
